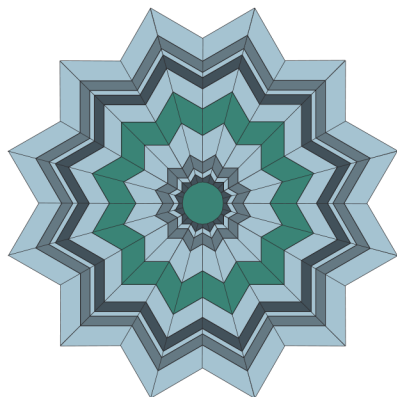


# Squedge 15 Striped Topper



Finished Size: 23" x 23"

Fabric	Number of strips	Strip width	Amount Used	Suggested Yardage
<b>A</b>	two identical	8" x fabric width	16"	½ yd*
<b>C</b>	one	3" x 3"	3"	⅛ yd
Backing			25" x 25"	¾ yd
Batting			25" x 25"	¾ yd

\*Based on a vertical stripe, you may need more fabric for a horizontal stripe. Make sure you have 2 full repeats of your stripe pattern. Adjust yardage accordingly.

## Prepare the Squedge 15 tool

Apply non-slip disks to the back of the Squedge tool. For mirror image cuts, you will need to turn the fabric over to the wrong side for cutting.

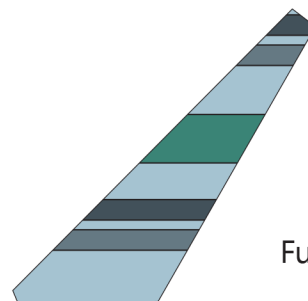
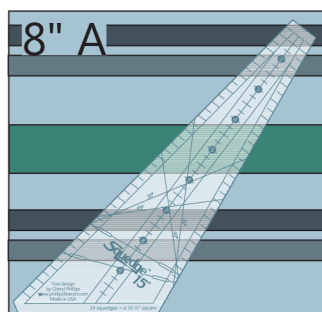
## Cutting Strips

Cut two *identical* 8" strips from fabric A.

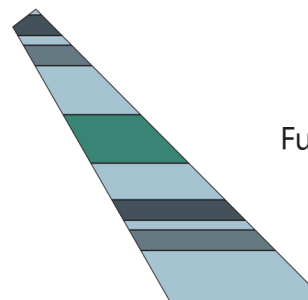
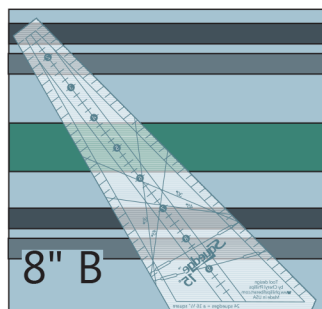
Place the Squedge 15 tool base on the bottom edge of the strip set.

Cut **12 identical** Full Squedge pieces.

Cut **12 identical** Reverse Full Squedge pieces.  
*Reverse is found by flipping the tool over with words down.*

Cut 12 Reverse Full Squedges

Pin a Squedge to a mirror image (reverse) Squedge aligning the stripes. Pin to match the stripes.

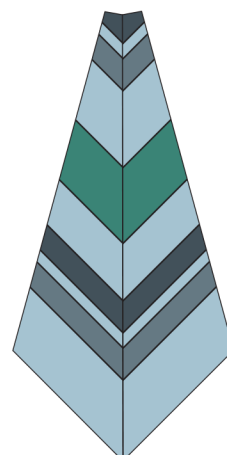
Sew the two together.

Sew **12** pairs.

Sew the pairs together to form the topper.

Press the seam allowances from the back, then repeat on the front side.

*The direction you press is up to you. Pressing all the seam allowances in a counter clockwise direction is one option. You may also open the seam allowances for a flatter topper.*

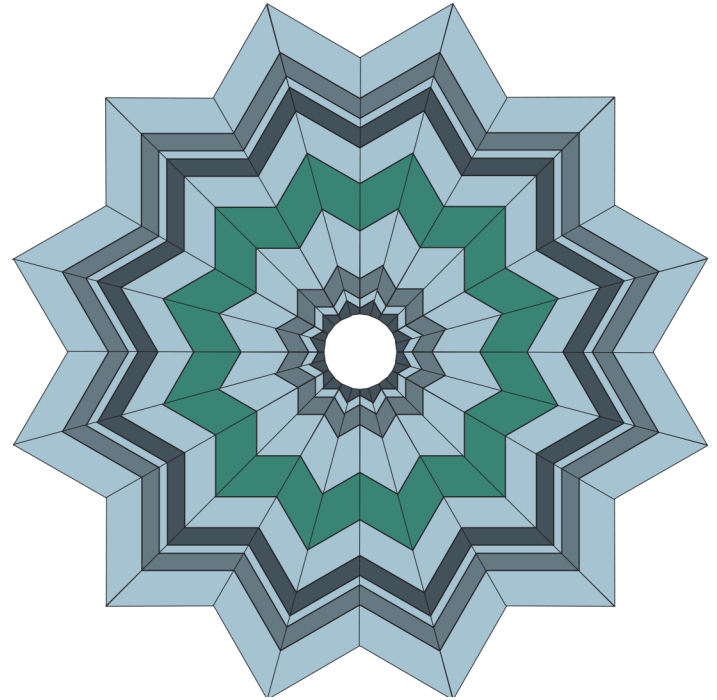
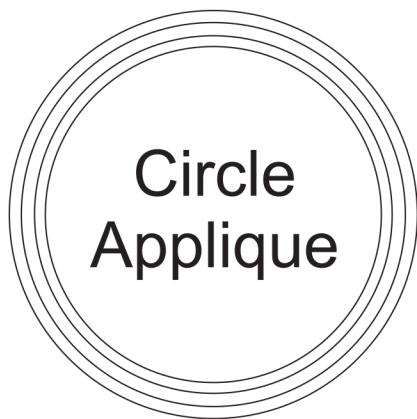
Iron a square of freezer paper to the back of the project to stabilize the center opening.

Trace a circle onto freezer paper.

Iron the freezer paper onto a scrap of fabric you've chosen for your center applique.

Cut the fabric, allowing  $\frac{1}{4}$ " for turning under.

Applique the circle to the center opening.



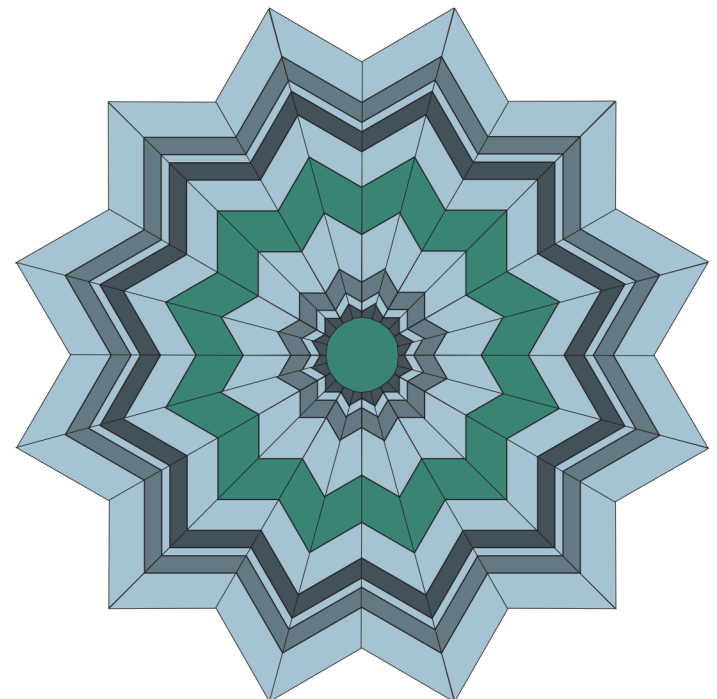
Finish the project using the "pillow case" method. Layer the backing (right side up), batting, then pieced top (right side down).

Pin the layers together.

Sew around the perimeter, leaving a place for turning.

Trim away the excess backing and batting. Clip at the inside corners.

Now turn the piece inside out and hand stitch the opening closed.



Finished Size: 22  $\frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter
